Dear Woodville Union School District Parents,

As of February 28, 2022, crediting continued improvements in COVID-19 conditions, Governor Newsom and his Administration announced a midnight March 11 end to California's school mask requirements for all students regardless of vaccination status. As of February 25, the federal requirement for face masks on school buses also ended.

The announcement comes following California's transition to an endemic approach to COVID-19 mitigation and what health officials are calling a state of "normalcy". Parents and students wishing to continue to wear a mask after March 11 may also do so. It will be a parental choice and decision. The Woodville USD Board of Trustee and Administration supports this decision. The Newsom Administration also indicated that CDPH and CalOSHA requirements for staff will be aligned to the Governor's announcement.
