Modified Quarantine via Testing Flowchart for Unvaccinated Students

This decision tree is for school nurses and/or COVID-19 delegates determining eligibility for modified quarantine options in the school setting per the current <u>CDPH K-12 guidance</u> and <u>CPDH K-12 guidance FAQ</u>. Fully vaccinated staff and students do not need to quarantine after an exposure if they have no symptoms. Isolation and testing are still indicated for anyone with symptoms regardless of vaccination status. At-home testing kits are <u>not</u> accepted for modified quarantine at this time.

Modified quarantines allow **students** to test out of quarantine early to reduce impact on in-person learning; test options vary by risk. 14 days of quarantine is the gold standard, however 10 days is the requirement by CDPH for unvaccinated persons. Everyone quarantining less than 14 days should continue all recommended preventive measures: self-monitor for symptoms, wear a mask, physically distance, and avoid high-risk persons and crowds through 14 days post-exposure.
