

If you have other adults that will pick-up your child, please give the teacher their name and contact information or call the office to notify the secretary. We are not permitted to dismiss your child for pick-up without this notification. At dismissal, students that ride the bus are walked to the bus, by their teacher.

Dear Parents,

Below you will find the following bus schedule for Woodville Elementary School. We ask that **students be at their appropriate bus stop ten minutes before the scheduled pickup time**. The bus **will not** stop if the student is inside the house, garage, or on the front porch. Pickup times may be adjusted during the first few weeks of school and can fluctuate from day-to-day during the school year due to issues such as traffic, weather, temporary road construction, etc.

Bus # 8 – (Mr. Oscar Baez)

- First stop will be at Superior Market 16638 Rd 168 (gas station North side of the road) at 7:00am
- Second stop will be at 17798 Rd 152 at 7:08 am.
- Third stop will be 15999 Ave 168 (South side of the road) at 7:13 am.
- Final stop across from the Memorial Building (on the south side of the road) 7:15 am.

Bus # 12- (Mr. David Carmona)

- First stop will be the Woodville Labor Camp at 7:00 am.
- Second stop will be 16960 Ave 152 at 7:10 am.
- Final stop will be 19152 Ave 152 at 7:15 am.

Bus # 8 – (Mr. Oscar Baez)

- Second run to the Woodville Labor Camp at 7:20 am.
- Stop at 15950 Rd 192 at 7:25 am.

Bus # 12 (Mr. David Carmona)

- Second run to the Woodville Labor Camp at 7:30 am.
